

Personal Data Processing Policy

– for Attorneys

Your trust is crucial to us. When you register on our website as an attorney, you entrust us with your personal and professional data. Therefore, we want to be completely transparent about how we handle it.

Who We Are

The personal data controller is **Známý právník s.r.o.**, ID No. (IČO) 23588021, with its registered office at Střížkovská 717/30, Prague 8, 180 00, e-mail: tady@juster.cz.

What Data We Process About Attorneys

We only process data that you provide to us yourself during registration, data generated during our cooperation, or data that may be published within the provision of legal services, in particular:

- **Identification and contact details** (first name, last name, name of the law firm, e-mail, phone number, registered office/office address).
 - **Data regarding registration in the list of attorneys** (e.g., registration number with the Czech Bar Association - ČAK).
 - **Your professional specialization and area of expertise.**
 - **Data regarding previous cooperation and forwarded inquiries.**
 - **Any other data** you choose to share with us during communication.

For What Purposes We Process Data

We process your data exclusively for the purpose of:

- Maintaining and managing the database of registered attorneys.
 - Connecting you with potential clients based on your specialization and location.
 - Forwarding client inquiries.
 - Providing information about the Juster service.

- Performing related administrative and technical tasks.

Legal Basis for Processing

The primary legal basis is the **performance of a contract** under Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR – i.e., fulfilling obligations arising from the registration and cooperation between you and us.

Furthermore, your personal data may be processed on the basis of the **legitimate interest** of the controller pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, in particular for the purpose of:

- Recommending unregistered attorneys who publicly offer their specialized legal services.
- Keeping a record of contact details for a reasonable period after the cooperation ends, in order to protect the legal claims of the controller and ensure the security and integrity of the system.

The controller's legitimate interest consists primarily in ensuring the functionality of the service, being able to respond to specific user requests and assist them, protecting the controller's rights, and preventing misuse of the system. The processing is strictly limited to the necessary scope of personal data, is based on publicly available information, and does not disproportionately interfere with the rights and freedoms of the data subjects.

Who May Receive the Data

- **Potential clients** inquiring about legal services matching your specialization (to the extent necessary to establish contact).
- **Software and technical service providers** who ensure the operation of our website, database, and administrative tasks for us (so-called personal data processors).

Note: We do not transfer your data outside the EU.

How Long We Retain the Data

We retain the data for the duration of your registration, cooperation, or for a reasonable period after providing the contact (even for unregistered attorneys), unless it is necessary to retain it for a longer period due to legal obligations or legitimate interests (e.g., for resolving potential disputes).

Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Request access to the data we hold about you.
- Request correction, erasure, or restriction of processing.
- Object to processing based on legitimate interest.
- Withdraw consent to processing at any time (if consent is the legal basis).
- Lodge a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection.

Data Security

We protect your data both technically and organizationally – we use secure data transmission (HTTPS), access controls, regular security audits, and encrypted storage.
